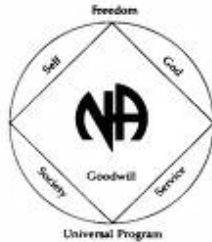

The quote they got from the insurance company would come out to costing \$11 for each home group per year. This insurance would cover all accidental instances of our meetings and our functions.
